18 an impoundment order for up to six months as follows:

19 (i) The impoundment of the vehicle or combination  
20 shall occur within the municipality where the offense was  
21 committed.

22 (ii) Direct enforcement of the impoundment order  
23 shall be conducted by a police officer, constable or  
24 impoundment official as directed by the judicial  
25 authority. In a city of the first class, second class,  
26 second class A and third class, the impoundment official  
27 shall be a parking authority of the municipality as  
28 authorized under section 6109 (relating to specific  
29 powers of department and local authorities) and 53

1 Pa.C.S. Ch. 55 (relating to parking authorities).

2 (iii) The costs of a police officer, constable or  
3 impoundment official, reasonable storage costs and all  
4 other reasonable costs incident to the impoundment order  
5 shall be recoverable in addition to costs of prosecution.

6 (iv) The owner of the vehicle or combination which  
7 has been subject to an impoundment order may obtain  
8 possession of the vehicle or combination by:

9 (A) Furnishing proof of valid registration and  
10 financial responsibility.

11 (B) Paying all costs and reasonable fees  
12 associated with the impoundment order or making  
13 arrangements with the appropriate judicial authority  
14 to make payments of all costs and reasonable fees by  
15 installments as provided by the Pennsylvania Rules of  
16 Criminal Procedure.

17 (v) Any impounded vehicle or combination not  
18 recovered under this subsection may be sold as an  
19 unclaimed vehicle under section 6310 (relating to  
20 disposition of impounded vehicles, combinations and  
21 loads).

22 Amend Bill, page 5, lines 14 through 16, by striking out "and  
23 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to a term of" in line 14,  
24 all of line 15 and "years" in line 16

25 Amend Bill, page 6, line 1, by striking out "3" and inserting
